2 scholarships will be given in-order-to send MnAFPM members to the National ASFPM Conference in Oklahoma City, OK, which runs May 16-21, 2010.

This conference is a great opportunity to network and learn more about floodplain management.

The scholarship can be applied towards airfare, conference registration (package or basic), hotel room, transportation between the airport and hotel, and a food per diem (up to federal allowance). (ASFPM membership fees must be paid by the recipient).

The maximum scholarship amount for government employees is \$1,900 and \$2,200 for non-governmental employees. The difference in the scholarship amounts is because the hotel room rate varies depending on who employs the applicant.

Applicant **MUST** be a 2010 MnAFPM member. Preference will be given to applicants who plan to be involved with the MnAFPM. To apply, please submit a Letter of Interest and send it back by **February 20th**. Information on the conference and registration forms is available at www.floods.org

The Letter of Interest must include:

- Your name, job title, employer, mailing address, work phone number with extension, and email address.
- A brief explanation of why attending the 2010 ASFPM Conference would benefit your county/community/state/firm and increase your involvement in MnAFPM.
- Limited to one page in length.
